

allergy (アレルギー)

Excessive **sensitivity** to a substance, as **pollen**, **feathers**, or dust, or a chemical, such as a **detergent**, **cosmetic** or drug.

Allergy is the cause of **hay fever** and **hives**, and may be the cause of many cases of **asthma**, **eczema** and **sinusitis**.

Allergic reactions are an exaggeration of the normal immune response to bacteria, virus, etc. Normally, the body responds to invasion by forming **antibodies** to fight the invader. The allergic response is similar, except that the **antibodies** react with the **allergen**, or invader substance, to cause the body to release chemicals that create undesirable **side effects**. Allergic reactions are most common in the **respiratory tract** and the skin, though they may also affect the **digestive system**.
